Visiting Hours

General Visiting Hours 11 am - 8 pm

Intensive Care Units

Surgical Intensive Care Unit (SICU)	11 am - 8 pm
Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU)	24 hours for parents (one parent may stay overnight) 11 am - 8 pm all other visitors
Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)	24 hours for parents (no siblings or other visitors allowed) 12 pm - 2 pm & 5 pm - 7 pm for grandparents
Post-Anesthesia Care Unit (PACU)	11 am - 8 pm (20-minute visits only)
Maternity Unit	9 am - 10 pm for fathers and partners 1 pm - 2 pm & 5 pm - 7 pm for siblings 11 am - 8 pm for all other visitors
Emergency Department	24 hours (one visitor at a time)

- Please obtain a Visitors Pass from the front desk immediately upon entering the building.
- Children younger than 15 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Due to space limitations, only one parent may stay overnight in the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit.
- Visiting is limited to two persons at the patient's bedside at any given time. Only one visitor is allowed for Emergency Department patients.
