MESSAGE FROM TBHC'S PRESIDENT: TAKE ANOTHER LOOK AT TBHC!

I am thrilled to announce that The Brooklyn Hospital Center (TBHC) has received the highest grade "A" for patient safety from the prestigious Leapfrog Group.

TBHC is one of only two hospitals in all of New York City to get an "A" and is the only A-rated hospital in Brooklyn. In fact, only 8 percent of hospitals in the entire State of New York received this highest grade.

This "A" is really the culmination of a story we began in late 2015. Since then, TBHC has invested millions of dollars to hire top doctors and specialists who have created new approaches to care and have ensured a quality environment for patients.

Among the changes TBHC made and planned are:

- A new critical care initiative that improves outcomes for the sickest patients.
- The launch of the Epic electronic medical record, which provides better coordination of care.
- A \$23 million transformation grant to renovate the Emergency Department, beginning early 2019.
- A renovation plan for TBHC's Downtown Brooklyn campus.
- An expansion of the hospital's ambulatory network into the surrounding communities.

We are doing sound and savvy planning to Keep Brooklyn Healthy today and into the future. And, we are excited to be celebrating our 175th anniversary in 2020. These achievements—and, of course, this "A"—gives patients and the community an excellent reason to take another look at TBHC.

FAOS ABOUT THE LEAPFROG "A"

Q: What is Leapfrog and what does the grade measure?

A: The Leapfrog Group is a national nonprofit healthcare ratings organization that grades approximately 2,500 hospitals across the country on how well they keep patients safe from harm. Developed under the guidance of a Blue Ribbon National Expert Panel, the Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade uses multiple measures of hospital safety data to assign letter grades to hospitals twice per year.

O: Has The Brooklyn Hospital Center (TBHC) received an "A" before?

A: This is our first one! In fact, just three years ago, TBHC set out to become a high-reliable organization.



Implementation of many patient-safety best practices resulted in significant reductions in infections and hospital-acquired conditions. These efforts resulted in a "C" in 2017 (a typical grade for New York City hospitals). In spring 2018, we received a "B", which, at the time, was the best grade in Brooklyn. This "A" is a direct reflection of TBHC's emphasis on quality and patient safety during the last three years.

O: What does the "A" mean for TBHC's future?

A: In the securing this Leapfrog "A" grade, we are reinforcing the foundation of TBHC as a patient-focused institution and a pillar of our community. As we approach our 175th anniversary, as well prepare for the exciting real estate and strategic developments slated for the next years, patients and the community should know that they made a good choice in The Brooklyn Hospital Center. This is the bigger picture! The smaller picture—how the "A" affects specific departments, doctors and patients is a more nuanced story, or rather stories.
