Dr. Lee lived his entire life practicing Buddhist doctrine and guided many people in meditation and Buddhist teaching. He earned a PhD in Asian medicine, specializing in herbal science and acupuncture, and treated many patients until the last days of his life.

In gratitude for their service – and for the service of all those who help others out of the goodness of their hearts – Dr. Lee’s family created the Lotus Award to lift up shining examples of service to others and the community.
